3. The chosen standard closely matches the KRSPs.			
4. The correct verb and domain are used for the KR and Ss.			
5. All Products are written as tangible nouns.			
6. A skill or product is listed for all Knowledge and Reasoning.			
<b>ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION</b>			
7. The assessment methods match the domain.			
8. All domains are assessed.			
9. A variety of assessments are used. (Selected response, essay, performance assessment, etc.)			
10. There is an assessment for every KR and S.			
11. Only teacher or student made assessments are attached.			
12. Scoring guides, rubrics and checks lists are attached.			
13. Scoring guides are clearly written.			
14. Questions on the assessments match the targets. (KRSPs)			
15. An evaluation tool (rubric) is provided for the Product.

21. All of the materials used during Instruction are listed or identified as teacher resources.			
22. Published tests are referenced but not attached.			
23. Texts used in the lesson are referenced in the Resources as a bibliography.			
<b>POTENTIAL ACCOMODATIONS</b>			
24. Accommodations are written for special needs students.			
25. Accommodations are written for gifted students.			
26. Accommodations are written specifically for this lesson.			
<b>FOLLOW-UP</b>			
27. Specific activities are listed for remediation.			
28. Specific activities are written for extension.
